## **Application Procedures**

**All information is kept confidential.**

Financial assistance forms are available at all Boyertown Area YMCA Member Service Desks or on our website at [www.boyertownymca.org](http://www.boyertownymca.org).

Proof of income must be provided with all applications. (Copies of pay stubs, Federal income tax returns, food stamps, Social Security, SSI, child support, etc. are examples of proof needed.)

All applications must be completed in full and include all proof of income or cannot be processed.

Extraordinary expenses such as medical or educational expenses must be noted on the application and proof provided.

A sense of ownership and pride is felt when recipients of Golden Rule Financial Assistance contribute to the cost of YMCA services; therefore, all applicants are asked to pay a portion of the fee.

The application and proof of income should be put in a sealed envelope and dropped off at any YMCA Member Service Desk. Please note on the envelope: Attention: Ryan Rhoades.
